If the hearing in one of your patient's ears has suddenly become muffled or greatly reduced, consider this research study of an investigational treatment for sudden hearing loss.

To pre-qualify for the ASSENT study, a patient must:

- Be ≥ 18 years of age
- Have unilateral ISSNHL onset within 72 hours prior to study treatment
- Have severe to profound hearing loss
- Not have bilateral ISSNHL or hearing loss from other causes (e.g., noise trauma, barotrauma, or head trauma, Meniere's disease, autoimmune diseases, middle ear infection, etc.)

All study-related visits, tests, and study medication will be provided to participants at no cost. In addition, reimbursement for study-related time and travel may be provided.
