Did You Know?

Kentucky currently ranks third per capital nationally in people identified as deaf or hard of hearing according to Kentucky Commission on the Deaf and Hard of Hearing. (*KCDHH/Quick Facts 09-22-2011*)

Statistical demographics reveal that the total number of deaf or hard of hearing individuals in Warren County, Kentucky is 18,207. Reports from surrounding counties verify a large number of deaf or hard of hearing citizens as well.
